



## **COOPERATION AGREEMENT**

BETWEEN THE

**SANTIAGO ARBITRATION AND MEDIATION CENTER**

AND THE

**SINGAPORE INTERNATIONAL ARBITRATION CENTRE**


Being convinced that the use of mediation, international commercial arbitration and other forms of alternative dispute resolution through fair, inexpensive and expeditious procedures lends confidence and stability to trade and investment between and among nations, the Santiago Arbitration and Mediation Center of the Santiago Chamber of Commerce (CAM Santiago) and the Singapore International Arbitration Centre (SIAC) agree as follows:

1. The institutions shall, upon request, recommend to each other suitable individuals to serve as mediator(s) or arbitrator(s) to act in a specific case, or to serve on the roster of mediators or arbitrators of an institution.
2. The Institutions shall, whenever possible, facilitate lectures, conferences or seminars of mutual interest in the field of international commercial arbitration, mediation and other forms of alternative dispute resolution.

3. The Institutions shall exchange information and publications on commercial arbitration, mediation and other forms of alternative dispute resolution, either electronically or in hard copy, whichever is appropriate.
4. Nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed to constitute a partnership between the Institutions nor constitute any Institution the agent of the other for any purpose or entitle any Institution to commit or bind the other in any manner.
5. This Agreement is made in 2 original copies in English and shall become effective on 1 January 2009.


